- Chemicals for indoor use, wood preservatives, cleaning and care products
- Construction materials
- Furniture

Among others, these are the criteria for the certificate to be awarded:

Awarded products

- must be healthy and well-tolerated
- must have low emissions
- must have a favourable influence on room climate and comfortableness
- should provide for an amelioration of room air quality
- must have favourable psychological features, e.g. with regard to colour design, aesthetics, choice of material, harmony, room atmosphere, well-being
- should help increase contentment, comfort and health inside lodgings
- should have a favourable influence on utility value and expediency of lodgings
